

ORDINANCE NO. Z-A

An Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 2, being the Noise Ordinance of the Township of Lincoln, Midland County, Michigan.

The Township of Lincoln, Midland County, Michigan, ordains pursuant to the authority vested in it by Act 246 of the Public Acts of the State of Michigan for 1945, as amended, the following amendments to Lincoln Township Noise Ordinance, Ordinance No. 2:

SECTION 1:

Section VI, Penalty, is hereby amended and shall hereafter read as follows:


Section VI. Penalty. Any person or other entity who violates any provision of this Ordinance is responsible for a municipal civil infraction as defined by Michigan law and subject to a civil fine of not more than \$500.00, plus costs, which may include all direct or indirect expenses to which the Township has been put in connection with the violation. In no case, however, shall costs of less than \$9.00 or more than \$500.00 be ordered. In addition all violations of this Ordinance or any part thereof are declared a nuisance per se. The Township specifically reserves the right and shall have the authority to proceed in any Court of competent jurisdiction for the purpose of obtaining any injunction, restraining order or other appropriate remedy to abate said nuisance and to compel compliance with this Ordinance.

SECTION 2:


This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after publication thereof.
